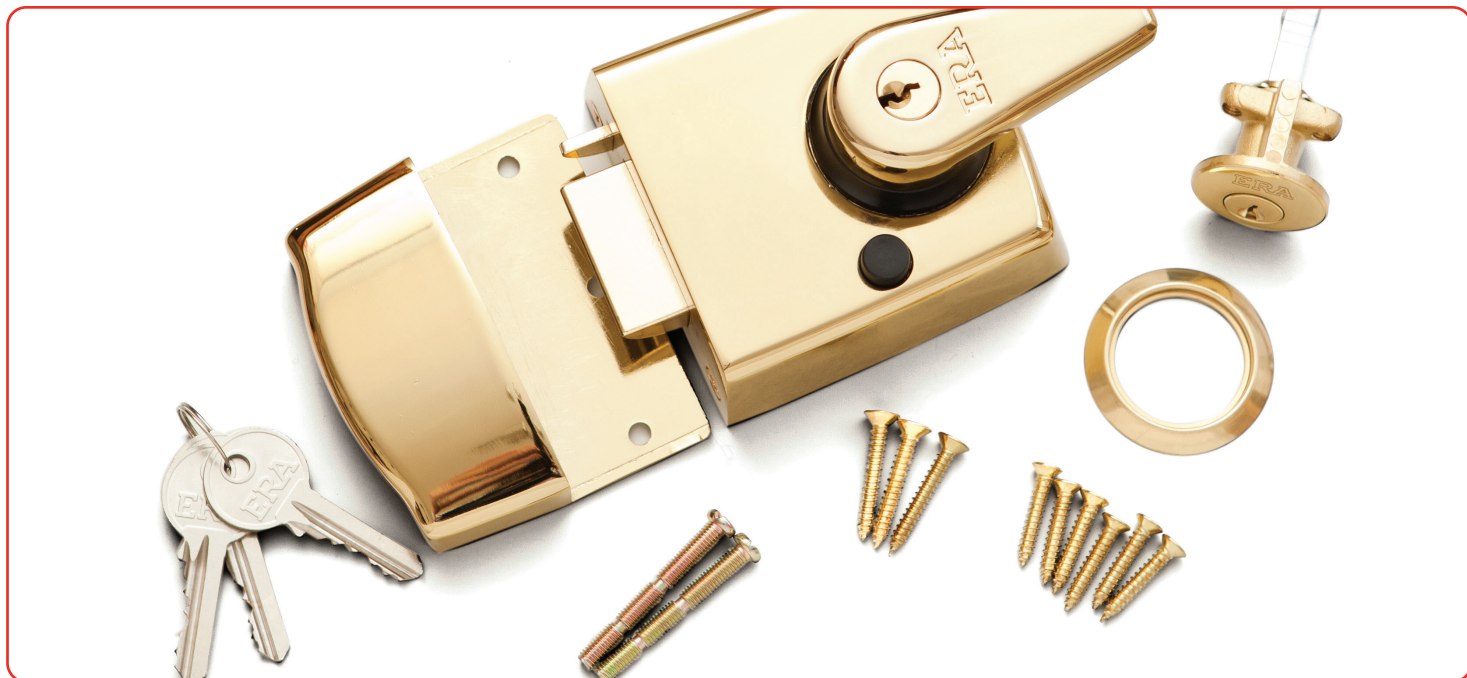


Double Locking Nightlatch



Features

- The **Double Locking Nightlatch** is designed to replace most existing front door locks
- Ideally suited for solid and glass panelled wooden doors
- Designed with an ergonomic internal locking handle offering added security against forced entry
- The main lock bolt is automatically deadlocked when the door is closed, preventing the main bolt being retracted by a credit card
- The inside handle can be deadlocked by an anti-clockwise turn of the key from the inside so securing the lock against forced entry
- The bolt can be held in the withdrawn position (only) with the use of the snib feature
- Available in 40mm and 60mm backsets
- Brass, Grey, Satin Chrome, Polished Chrome and Satin Nickel finishes available

Packaging

Boxed version

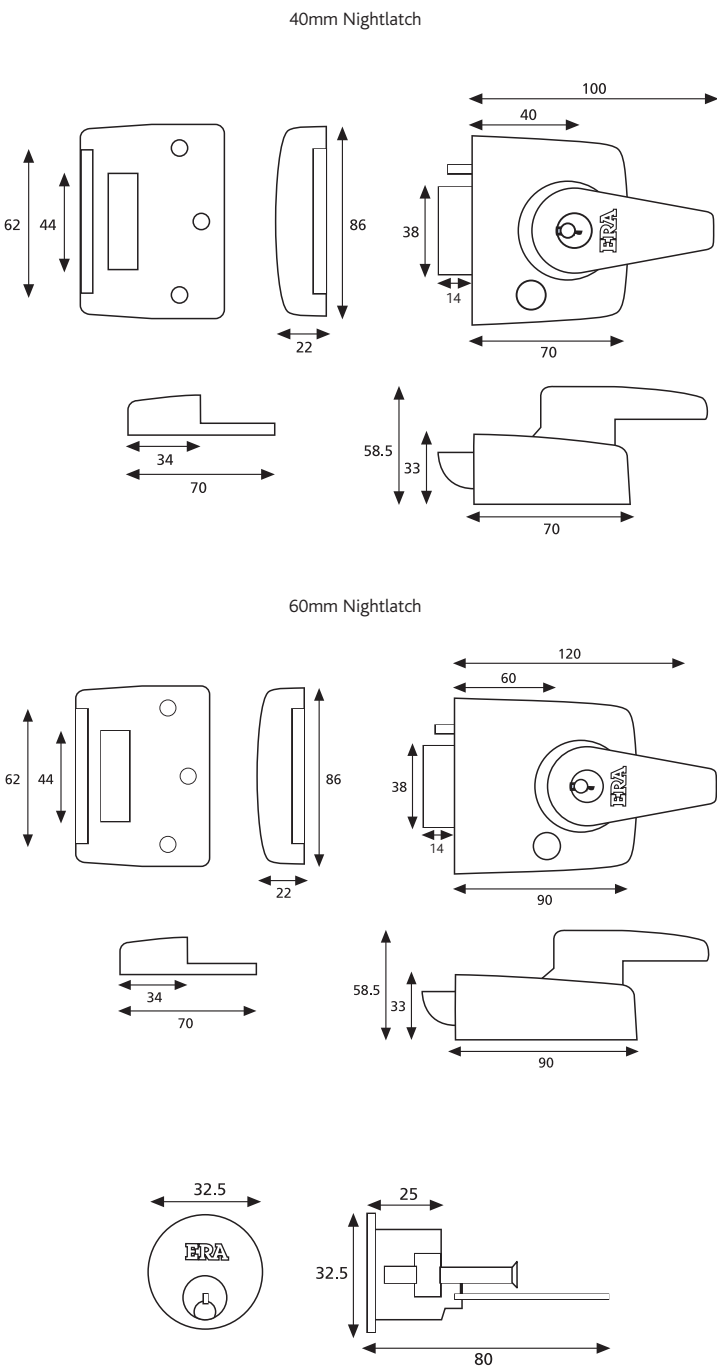
1 lock per inner box, 10 locks per outer box. 1.18Kg (40mm) 1.33Kg (60mm) per item, 11.8Kg (40mm) 13.0Kg (60mm) per outer box.

Retail Boxed version

Cardboard packaging with euro hooks. 1 lock per retail box, 6 retail boxes per outer box. 1.2Kg (40mm) 1.4Kg (60mm) per item, 7.2Kg (40mm) 8.4Kg (60mm) per outer box

Maintenance

Wipe the surface periodically with a soft cloth to remove excess grease or moisture.
